ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY LAWN CARE TIPS

MOW YOUR LAWN CORRECTLY

Mow high and mow often. Only take off about half of the length of the grass. You'll get an attractive, neatly trimmed lawn, and clippings will disappear when they filter down to the soil. **Mulching Blade.** Most new mowers are mulching mowers or attach mulching equipment to your existing mower.

THE RIGHT AMOUNT OF WATER

Controlling watering lets lawn grow at manageable levels and still stay healthy. Don't water until the lawn is dry. If it turns blue-green or gray, or if footprints don't spring back, it's time to water.

Early morning watering conserves water by preventing evaporation.

LAWN ADDITIVES

TOO MANY LAWN PRODUCTS, TOO OFTEN. Heed and follow product label warnings seriously. (More is not better) Lawn additives are powerful chemicals and you need to use them correctly.
